Cantiere delle Marche, on Italy's Adriatic coast, built Audace. It took two years and 200,000 man-hours to complete the yacht. To ensure she could handle the toughest conditions, Audace came with one-inch-thick steel plating around the bow and a pair of Caterpillar C32 Acert diesel engines to drill her through the roughest seas at 18 mph. At a more majestic 12 mph, she has a transatlantic range of 5,400 nautical miles.

Equipped with a host of customized "toys", including a Land Rover Defender 4×4 and a BMW R 1200 GS off-road motorcycle, Audace is an explorer yacht that embodies the perfect marriage of ruggedness and luxury. An imposing nine-ton crane, painted Ferrari red, handles all this equipment with ease.

For guests, the Audace offers two guest cabins on the lower deck, with drop-down balconies, as well as two VIP cabins on the upper deck. The owner's "penthouse apartment" offers ultimate luxury, with a bedroom, living room, study and a stern terrace with whirlpool bath, offering stunning views from its nearly 50 feet above the water.

Originally built for an Italian owner, M/Y audace is now owned by a new owner who wants to use this 46m yacht as a tool for exploration. Numerous voyages are planned over the coming years to help this new owner discover the world's highest and most inaccessible lands.
