






1. PRESENTATION

Founded by Prince Rainier III in 1953 and presided by HSH Prince Albert II since 1984, Yacht Club de Monaco is an exclusive private club which unites 2,500 members from 80 nationalities. In accordance with its statutes, this private club differs from others in that it also has a public service remit. Not only does it play a key role in bringing life to the harbour, and as a catalyst for all yachting related activities in Monaco, YCM contributes to promoting the Principality and its influence abroad. At the instigation of its President HSH Prince Albert II, it pursues a dynamic environmental policy.

The Yacht Club de Monaco is often solicited by new destinations wishing to benefit from its expertise and holistic vision of yachting. Its commitments and the values it upholds have made it one of the most respected and influential yacht clubs in the world, as well as being an undisputed major architect of the Monaco Capital of Yachting project launched in 2012.

This approach to further boost the Principality's appeal consolidates its status as a unique place and centre of excellence in this sector and became recently "Monaco Capital of *Advanced Yachting*". By calling on the skills of many professionals and stakeholders that make up the industry, Monaco has an essential role to play in the development of Luxury Yachting. Being at the forefront of major changes and innovations driving the sector, Monaco is providing concrete, tangible responses to environmental issues that need to be addressed.




2. ARRIVING AT THE YCM




ACCESS BY TRAIN

The train station is 11 minutes walk from the YCM. Use exit Port / Ste Dévote and head straight to the YCM by the quayside.

ACCESS BY AIR

7 minutes flight by helicopter from airport to YCM with **MONACAIR** | **BLADE**



ACCESS WITH VEHICLES

Vehicles under 2 metres in length must be parked in Monaco's public car parks. Please refer to the Services Map. Oversize vehicles may park in the "Esplanade des Pêcheurs" trailer park having been given prior approval by the YCM & must always be identifiable (contact details to be displayed under the windscreen).

ACCESS WITH TRAILERS

The "Esplanade des Pêcheurs" trailer park is available for the duration of the event.

ACCESS WITH HEAVYWEIGHT VEHICLES

Special authorisation are required to access weight restricted roads.



(Request must be submitted at least 3 working days prior to the date of movement). Please find below a link to the government website for heavyweight vehicles exceeding the authorised load:

Kindly note that movements for vehicles over 7.5t are not allowed between 8.00am and 9.00am in the Principality of Monaco.



4. ENVIRONMENTAL MEASURES

The Clubhouse was conceived to be cutting edge in terms of aesthetics and technology. Built to HQE® (Haute Qualité Environnementale) standards (low-noise construction, hygrothermal comfort, acoustics, water quality, etc.), the project integrated photovoltaic panels, LED low energy lighting, systems to manage energy, waste and water usage, a cooling system that **recycles seawater** from the harbour and solar tubes, and with all electricity consumed produced from renewable sources.



Charging stations for electric vehicles (cars & boats) are available in the YCM Marina which also offers to transfer owners by electric cars.



Three electric tenders are used by the Sports Section to supervise sailing classes & during races.

YCM is also working on construction of a **Zero Emission Committee Boat** for its regattas.

Built entirely of aluminium and therefore easily recycled, the boat designed by Espen Oeino aims to be as quiet as possible to minimise the impact of noise on marine wildlife.

For vessels with a diesel engine, YCM now uses a **100% ecocircular synthetic biofuel** that is guaranteed to reduce carbon impact by up to -85%.



Since 2018, Yacht Club de Monaco only uses electricity generated from renewable energy sources.

- YCM has the Egeo certificate and the E-label that falls within the Climate Energy Plan objectives.
- YCM signed the National Energy Transition Pact on Wednesday 7th June 2021.
- ISO 14001 Certification since 2016.





SUSTAINABILITY & EVENT ORGANISATION

The Yacht Club de Monaco has been engaged for many years in organising its races in a sustainable way. Some of the actions are listed below:


Dynamic Buoys: equipped with an electric motor to maintain their position throughout a race they do not need to be anchored, which helps protect the seabed, and are exceptionally accurate when the Race Committee is setting a course.

Printed material reduced to the minimum for sporting events. When printing is required only FSC paper is used. When possible, no Hull/Bow stickers are printed as they may fall in the water. This is not always possible, depending on the type of regatta.



SOCIAL EVENTS:

organic fruits & vegetables, local providers. Recyclable cutlery, glasses & plates are provided when standard tableware cannot be used.



IN COMPETITION:

All competitors are kindly asked to respect the environment by disposing of any rubbish in the bins provided, and to put cigarette butts in the ashtrays installed along the quay.

YCM strongly recommends that people replace plastic bottles with refillable water bottles. A water fountain is available in the Sports Section.


FILMING AND DRONES




BOARDING






Smart-Casual (no flip-flops or sandals).


