NOTICE OF RACE

2025, november 28th – November 30th

Hansa 303 Class

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The **Navicap Challenge – Elena Sivoldaeva Trophy** is organized by the Yacht Club de Monaco in collaboration with the Federation Monégasque de Voile (FMV) and the Federation Française de Voile (FFV).

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *Racing Rules of Sailing 2025 -2028*, the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions (SI), and the rules of the Hansa 303 Class.
- 2.2. Life jackets must be worn at sea. Infringement of this rule may lead to disqualification.
- 2.3. In the event of inconsistency or discrepancy between versions of the documents listed in paragraph 2.1, the English language version shall prevail.

3. ELIGIBLE CLASSES

Accepted Classes: **HANSA 303 double-handed**, provided by organizer and drawn at random.

4. ENTRIES

Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form on the Yacht Club de Monaco's website (www.ycm.org) before 28th of November 2025, and comply with the legislation of their country (FFV competition license currently valid for French people).

5. FEES

6.1. On the last day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be given to the competitors following registration confirmation by the Race Office on November 28th, 2025.

8. RACE COURSE

The course to be sailed will be triangular and describe in the Sailing Instructions (SI).

9. SCORING / QUALIFYING AND FINAL STAGES

The race will consist of qualifying and final phases.



- 9.1. One validated race is necessary to validate the regatta. A validated race corresponds to a Roud Robin (complete qualifying phase) when all groups have met each-other once.
- 9.2. The crews with the fewest points from all groups will qualify for the gold fleet. In the event of a tie, the finishing order of the last race will be used to decide between crews. The other crews will be awarded Silver, Bronze and Vermeil according to the same rules.

10. PENALTIES

Rule 44.1 of the RRS is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

11. ADVERTISING

- 11.1. Advertising must conform to regulation 20.4 of World Sailing.
- 11.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

12. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

Prize giving ceremony will be held at the Yacht Club de Monaco on Sunday November 30st, 2025.

13. MEDIA RIGHTS

- 13.1. **Navicap Challenge – Elena Sivoldaeva Trophy** competitors give absolute right and permission to the organisers and event sponsors to use, publish, broadcast, or otherwise distribute for promotional, advertising or any other purpose, any images and sounds recorded during the event of persons and boat free or charge.
- 13.2. All participants agree to waive their copyright claims to photographs taken during the event, and their right to have any recourse against organisers for the use made of these photographs.

14. PRICES

Prices will be awarded to the first three. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
